

Graduation Ceremony of TARA Akshar+ Neo-literates

ARA Akshar*, an ICT based Adult Literacy Programme of Development Alternatives, is being run in more than 8 states of India. The programme has made about 2 Lakh women functionally literate. Graduation ceremonies were organised at three locations - Aurai Block of Bhadohi District and Kachhauna Block of Hardoi District, Uttar Pradesh and Bhagwanpur Block of Haridwar District, Uttarakhand. More than 1650 TARA Akshar* neo-literates were felicitated with certificates for successful completion of the 56 days of literacy and numeracy teaching cycle. The chief guest of the function at Aurai, was Shri Nand Kumar Maurya, Chairman-Nagar Panchayat Khamariya, Aurai Block; and Shri Sunil Dutt Dubey, Station Officer, Aurai Block was the special guest.
